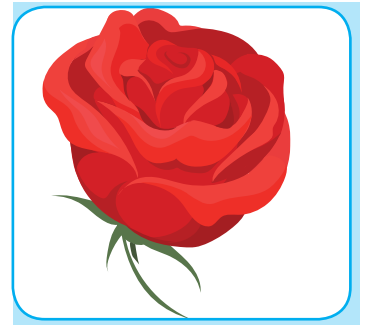
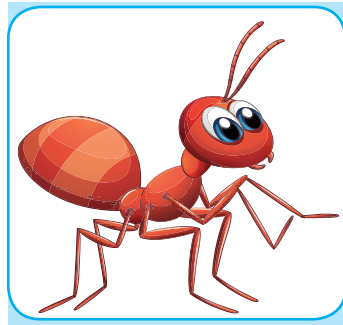


Adjective

Look at these pictures. Which word comes first to your mind to describe each of them?



You will most likely say: **sweet** mango, **huge** elephant, **tiny** ant and **beautiful** rose. The words **sweet**, **huge**, **tiny** and **beautiful** tell us something about the nouns 'mango', 'elephant', 'ant' and 'rose'.

Definition :

A word which describes a naming word or noun is called an **Adjective**.

Thus, the words sweet, huge, tiny and beautiful are adjectives.

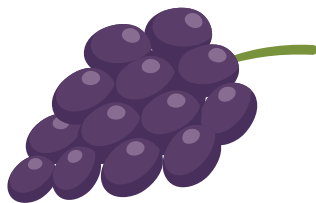

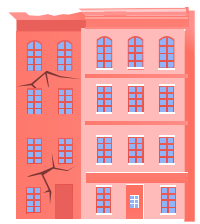

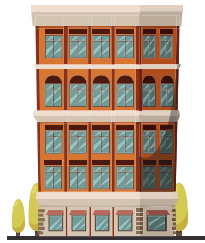
