



Verb

Look at these pictures. What is each person or animal doing in them?

The words jumping, dancing, writing and running show what is being done. In other words, they show 'action'.

Such **Doing words** or **Action words** are called **Verbs**.

Definition :

A **Verb** tells us what a person, animal or thing does.

The girl **sings** a song.




The boy **sits** on a chair.

Sheep and goats **eat** grass.




I **write** a letter.
