Vowel Combination

In English, a vowel combination is when two or more vowels are used together to create a specific sound. This is different from a single vowel sound, where only one vowel is used.

There are many vowel combinations in English, but some common ones include:

"ai" (as in "bait")

"ei" (as in "vein")

"ie" (as in "pie")
