Identification of Vowels

Vowels are the letters in the English alphabet that represent speech sounds made with an open vocal tract.

The 5 vowels are **A**, **E**, **I**, **O**, and **U**. Each vowel has a name and a sound that it represents.



Vowels are important because they help to form words and create different sounds. When you see one of these letters in a word, it will usually represent a vowel sound.

Once you can identify vowels, you can use them to build.

Read simple words.
