
Vowels and Consonants

Let us read the letters of the English alphabet once again.



Five letters of the alphabet a, e, i, o, u are given in green colour. These letters are called **Vowels**. The other twenty-one letters of the alphabet are called **Consonants**. Thus, the English alphabet contains **five vowels** and **twenty-one consonants**.
