

# Future Tense

## Use of the Future Tense

### Future Simple Tense

Future Simple Tense is used to express some future actions or events; as,

I **shall leave** for Lucknow tomorrow.

In this tense, **will** is used with the second and the third person pronouns (you, he, she, it and they), and **shall** is used with the first person pronouns (I and we).

### Future Tense

#### Future Simple Tense

I shall/will eat

You will eat

He/She will eat

We shall/will eat

They will eat

#### Future Perfect Tense

I shall/will have eaten You

will have eaten He/She

will have eaten We shall/

will have eaten They will

have eaten

#### Future Continuous Tense

I shall/will be eating

You will be eating

He/She will be eating

We shall/will be eating

They will be eating

#### Future Perfect Continuous Tense

I shall/will have been eating You will

have been eating

He/She will have been eating We

shall/will have been eating They will

have been eating
