Use of the Future Tense

Future Simple Tense

Future Simple Tense is used to express some future actions or events; as,

I shall leave for Lucknow tomorrow.

In this tense, will is used with the second and the third person pronouns (you, he, she, it and they), and shall is used with the first person pronouns (I and we).
