## A. Reflexive Pronouns

• The compound personal pronouns are called **Reflexive Pronouns** when the action done by the subject turns back (reflects) upon the subject; as,

In these sentences, the pronouns, herself, myself, yourself, ourselves, themselves, itself, and yourselves are acting as the objects to verbs, and refer to the same person or thing as that indicated by the subject of the verb.
