

Different Singular / Plural



The **child** was feeding a **biscuit** to a **puppy**.



The **children** were feeding **biscuits** to **puppies**.

- The nouns **child**, **biscuit** and **puppy** indicate one person, one thing and one animal respectively.
- The nouns **children**, **biscuits** and **puppies** indicate more than one person, more than one thing and more than one animal respectively.
- A Noun that denotes one person, animal or thing is said to be in the **Singular Number**.
- A Noun that denotes more than one person, animal or thing is said to be in the **Plural Number**.
