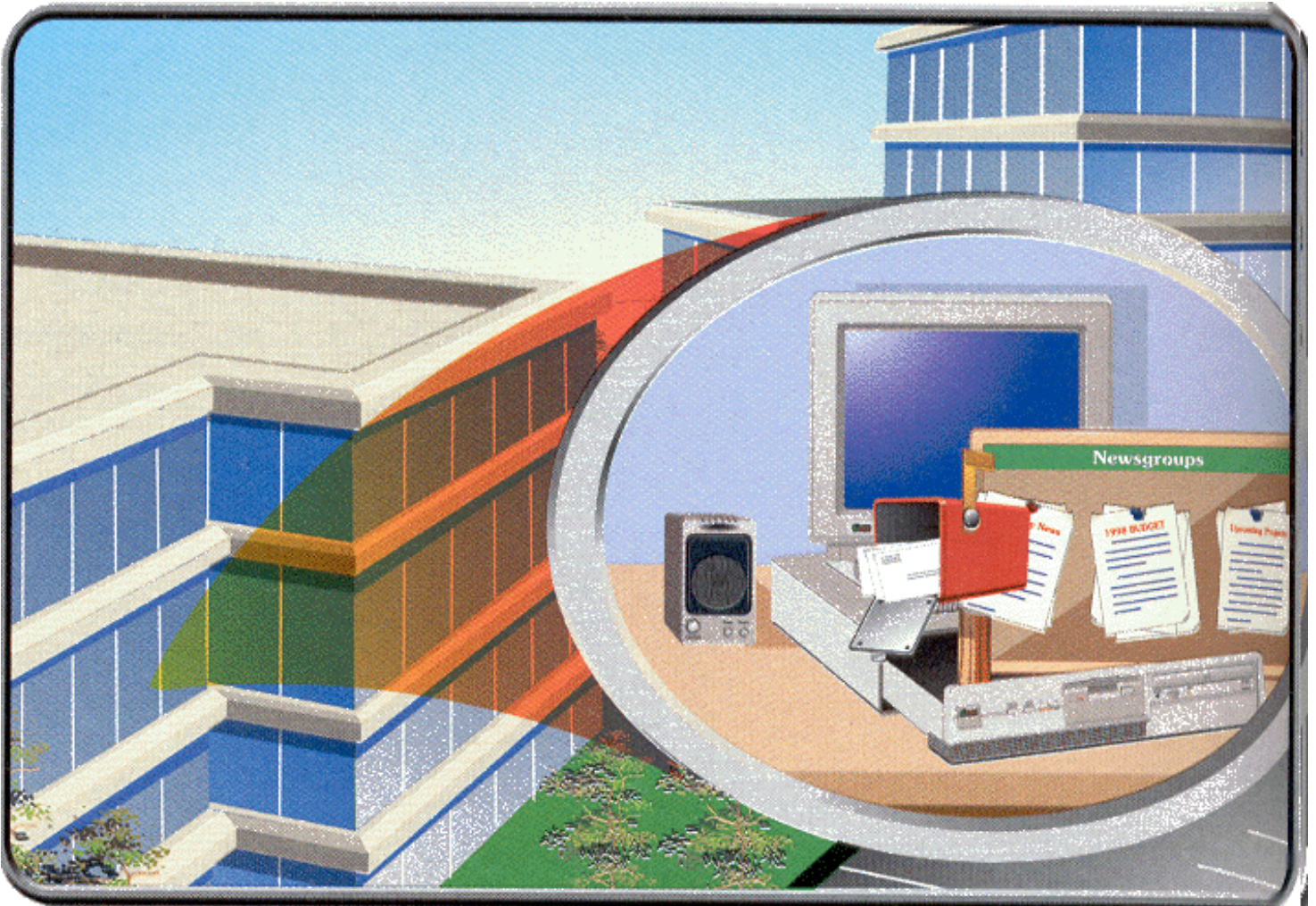


Introduction to Intranets
