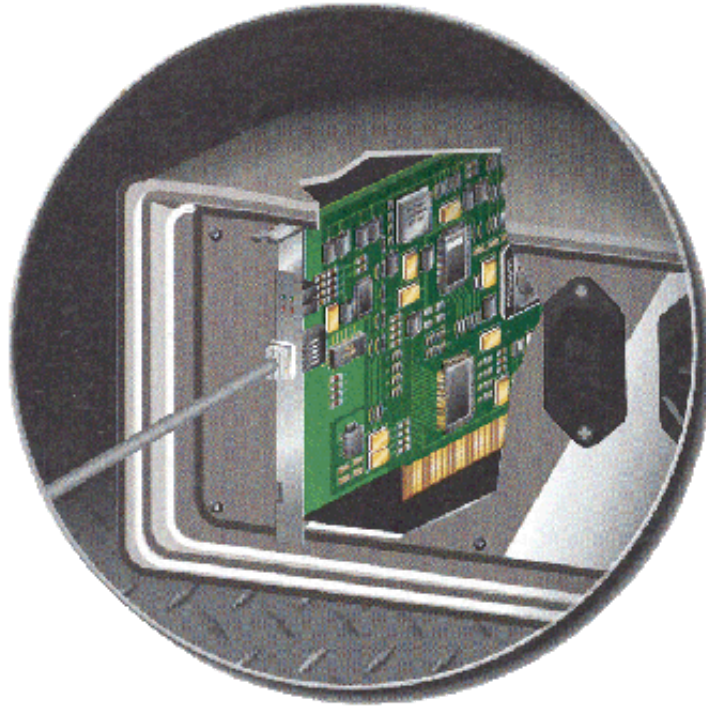


Network Interface Cards

A Network Interface Card (NIC) physically connects a computer to the transmission medium used on a network. A network interface card is installed inside a computer and controls the flow of information between the computer and the network. The type of transmission medium used on a network and the amount of information the transmission medium can transfer at once are factors that determine the type of network interface card required.
