Speakers


A **Speaker** is referred to the device that produces dynamic stereo sound.

The Speakers can be categorized as :-

Internal Speaker

All the computers come along with an Internal Speaker in the system unit, but it is not designed for Multimedia Applications. It is used only for system related purposes. For instance, the beep one hears on switching on the computer can alert, if there is any problem with the hardware.

As stated earlier, this Speaker does not have dynamic range to be used for Multimedia programs; thus a set of External Speakers is required.



External Speakers

Most Multimedia PCs have a couple of speakers attached to the Sound Card to provide stereo sound. It has its own set of amplifiers and a control knob. Some of these provide equalizing, mixing and matching features.
