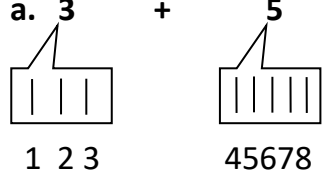


Addition and Stroke

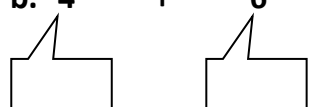
1. Add by drawing strokes. One is done for you.
