1. Solve word problems by arranging the numbers in tens and ones.

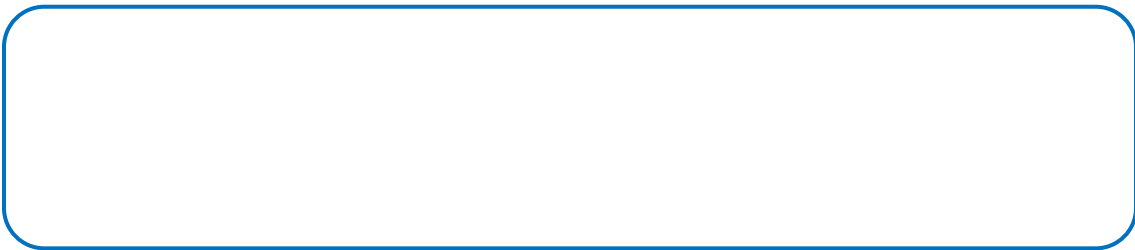
- a. There are 18 red pencils and 11 yellow pencils. How many pencils are there altogether?
