Life Skills

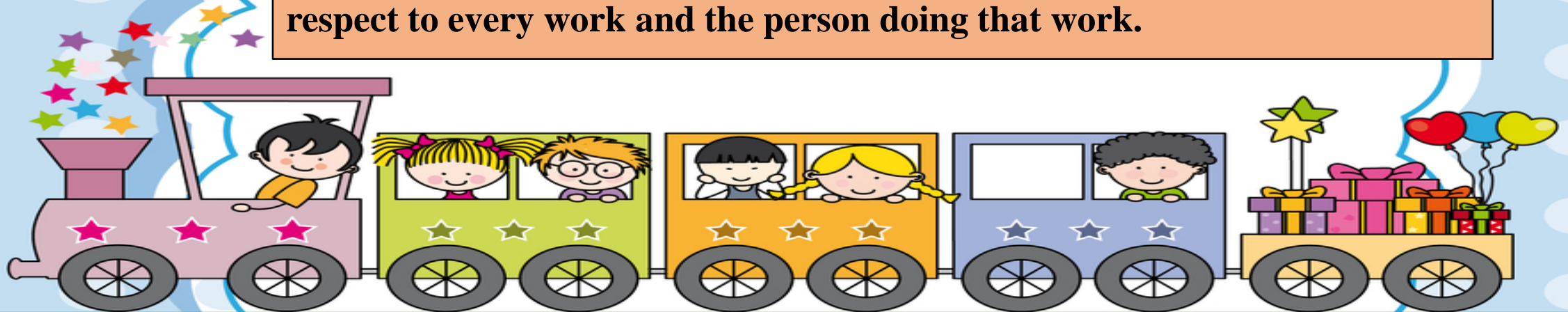
A. Respect work

Several people help us in our work. We should respect them.

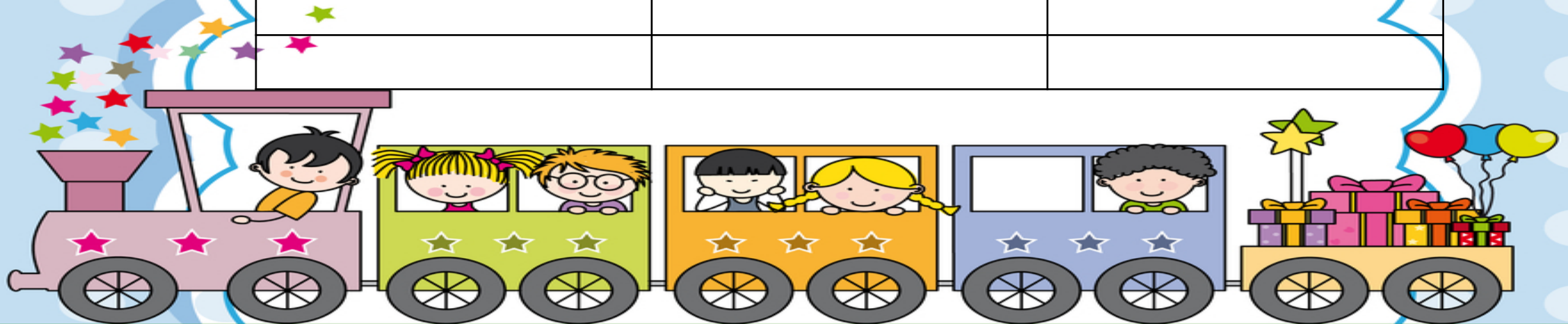
Every work is equally important.

Always remember, a sweeper is as important as a Doctor. Give respect to every work and the person doing that work.

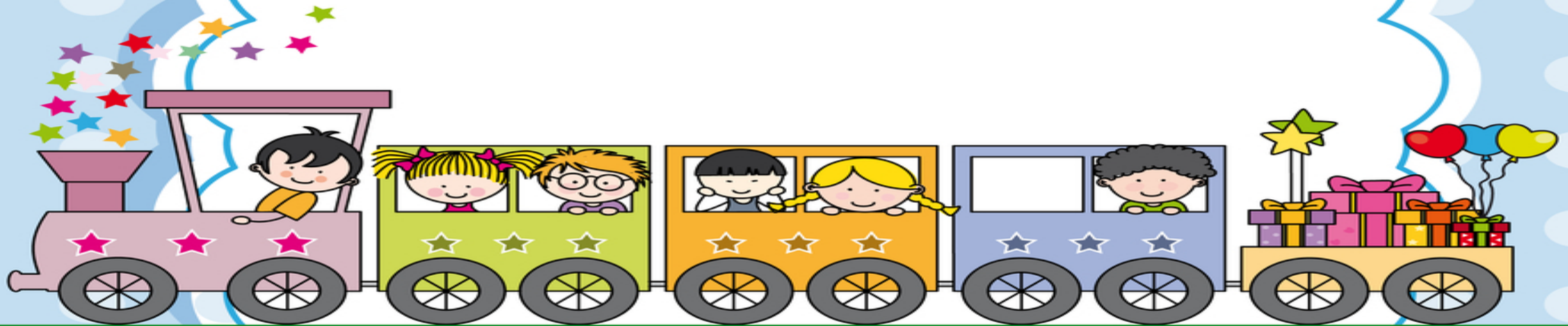
