




Paragraph Writing:

A paragraph is a small text written on a particular topic for a particular purpose. It can also be called as a group of sentences written on a same theme.



Guidelines to write a paragraph:

- 1. A paragraph always begins with a new line.
- 2. All the sentences in a paragraph should revolve around the main idea.
- 3. There should be proper sequencing of sentences in a paragraph.
- 4. There should be the use of connectors like firstly, secondly, lastly, moreover, however, and, but, in order to, instead of, as soon as, in addition to, so that, otherwise.



Example

Less TV, Better Behaviour

Young children who watch less TV are better behaved. Those children who spend two or more hours a day in front of the idiot box called television, are at an increased risk of developing behavioural problems. According to a survey, it is found that 16 per cent of parents say that their children watch two hours or more of television daily. The children who have a television in their bedroom have more behavioural problems, poor social skills and poor sleep. The children who watch less TV are likely to have less behavioural or social problems. They



are more obedient and able to manage their time well. Their lives are less stressful. Watching too much of television reduces creativity, and eventually the children turn out to become remotes themselves – inanimate and joyless. Their life is controlled by television and revolves around television. Childhood is the best period of life. It shouldn't be wasted in watching television. Less TV will make the children more organised and better behaved.


A. Read the passage given below and choose the correct answer for the following questions:




Hints for slogans:
