
Let's Write

Speech is when you express your thoughts and feelings to a group of people formally about a particular notion.


Organise your speech in the following way:

- Thank the audience for listening to you.








- Look at every member of your audience while speaking.

- Don't be too fast or too slow.




















Stop breeding of mosquitoes

Keep Malaria, Dengue and Chikungunya away Stay healthy



- Don't let water accumulate anywhere in and around your home.
- Fill up the potholes, ditches which have accumulated water.

- Keep all water-containing vessels, tanks, tightly covered with lids.
- Release Gambusia fish into wells, ponds. large pools of water. They eat the larvae of mosquitoes.







- Remove/Destory junk, unused materials.
- Empty and dry air coolers, drums. flower vases, plant pots, bird baths etc. every week.
- Use mosquito nets treated with insecticide while sleeping.
- Wear clothes which covers your body fully.



In case of symptoms like high fever accompanied with shivering, headache, bodyache, sweating, contact your nearest health worker/health centre immediately.
