






Attaining freedom from an empire was no small dream. But for them, it wasn't too big either.



An account of a person's life written by someone else is called biography.


- For writing a bio-sketch, first the facts are collected.

1913 : Birth, Alabama, USA.

1934 : After first World War : goes to school, teachers recognize and develop his athletic talents.

- **1935 : Six world records (indoor long jump).**
- **1936 : Berlin Olympics, four gold medals.**
- 1950 : Sports experts vote him Greatest Track Athlete of the Half Century.
- 1960 : Another athlete breaks Owens' last Olympic record
- **1980 : Dies of lung cancer**






