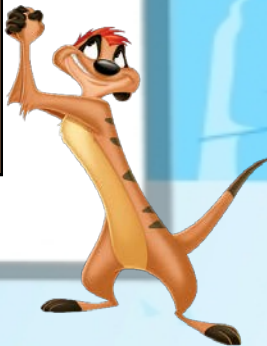

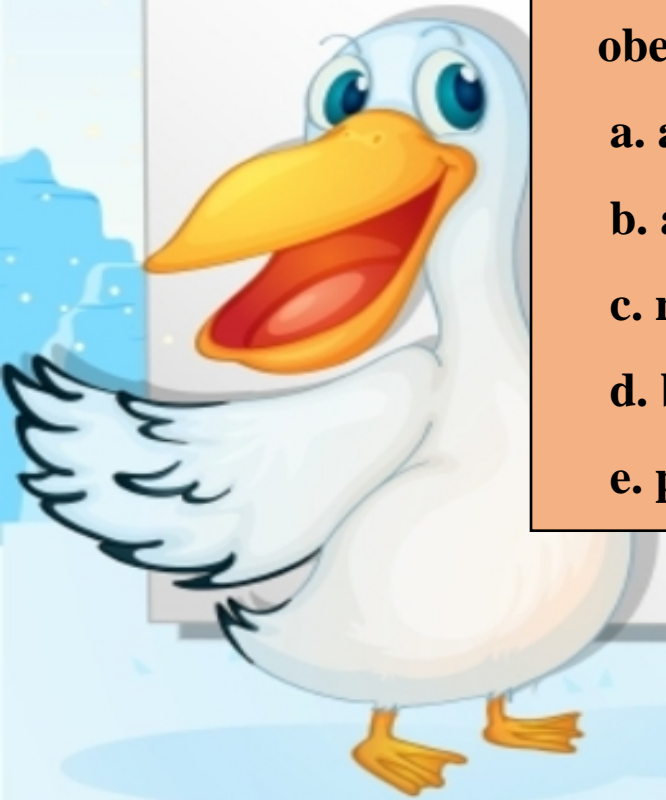


Life Skill
