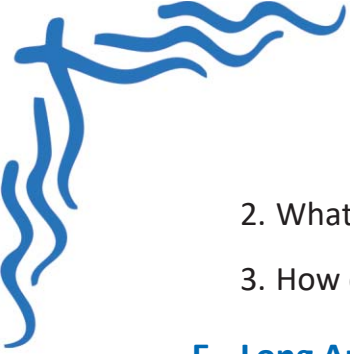
- In summer, they enjoyed ice creams and wore cotton clothes.
