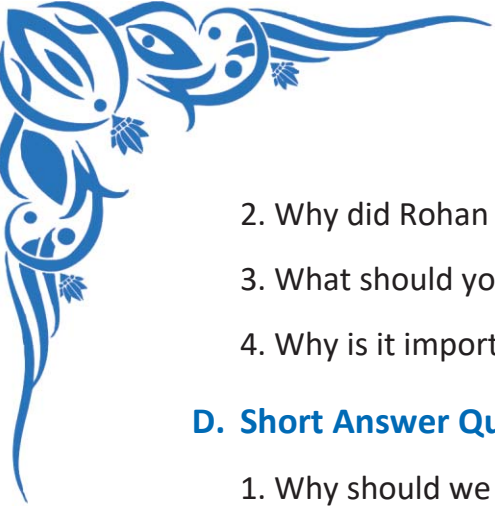
### C. Case Study:
