

# Synonyms and Antonyms

जिस प्रकार हिन्दी में शब्द के दो या दो से अधिक रूप होते हैं, उसी प्रकार अंग्रेजी में भी एक शब्द के दो या दो से अधिक रूप होते हैं। जिसमें शब्दों की समानता हो या similar प्रतीत होते हों, तो उन्हें Synonym कहा जाता है, तथा वे शब्द जिनमें शब्दों का अर्थ उल्टा (opposite) आए तो वे antonyms कहलाते हैं। जैसे- Respect का Synonym 'Regard' तथा Antonym 'Disrespect' है। विभिन्न Bank P.O., S.S.C., Clerk, L.I.C.

(A.A.O.) आदि परीक्षाओं में synonyms तथा antonyms से सम्बन्धित पांच या छः प्रश्न पूछे जाते हैं। उस शब्द के नीचे समानार्थक एवं भ्रमित करने वाले चार से पांच विकल्प दिये होते हैं। इन्हीं वैकल्पिक शब्दों में से उस शब्द को चुनना होता है जो दिए गए शब्द के अधिक नज़दीक (Close) है।

नीचे दिये हुए Synonyms तथा Antonyms को भली भाँति समझें और याद करें। ये आपकी परीक्षा में उपयोगी सिद्ध होंगे।
