Adding Numbers (Without Carrying)

Understanding the Topic

Addition means putting two or more numbers together to find the total. Without carrying means we add the digits in each place value and none of the sums go over 9. We add ones with ones, tens with tens, and hundreds with hundreds. This type of addition is simple because we don't need to carry over any value to the next place

How to Add Numbers Without Carrying

Step 1: Write the numbers in column form (ones, tens, hundreds)

Step 2: Start adding from the ones place

Step 3: Then add the tens place, then hundreds place

Step 4: Write the answer directly below each column

Examples with Solutions

Example 1:

Add: 123 + 245 Solution:

Ones: 3 + 5 = 8

Tens: 2 + 4 = 6

Hundreds: 1 + 2 = 3

Answer: 123 + 245 = 368

Example 2:

Add: 412 + 135

Solution:

Ones: 2 + 5 = 7

Tens: 1 + 3 = 4

Hundreds: 4 + 1 = 5

Answer: 412 + 135 = 547

Example 3:

Add: 521 + 276

Solution:

Ones: 1 + 6 = 7 **Tens:** 2 + 7 = 9 Hundreds: 5 + 2 = 7 **Answer:** 521 + 276 = 797 Example 4: Add: 304 + 152 Solution: **Ones:** 4 + 2 = 6 **Tens:** 0 + 5 = 5 **Hundreds:** 3 + 1 = 4 **Answer:** 304 + 152 = 456 Example 5: Add: 100 + 320 Solution: **Ones:** 0 + 0 = 0 **Tens:** 0 + 2 = 2 **Hundreds:** 1 + 3 = 4 **Answer:** 100 + 320 = 420

Summary Points

- Addition without carrying is simple and quick
- Add digits place by place (ones, tens, hundreds)
- No digit goes above 9 in any place
- Always align numbers properly in column format
