Understanding the Topic

- We see **different shapes** around us every day.
- **Shapes** help us **identify and describe** objects.
- Common shapes are **circle, square, rectangle, triangle, and oval**.
- Each shape looks **different** and is used in **different things**.

Common Shapes and Where We See Them

- **Circle** – Clock, coin, ball



- **Square** – Dice, window, tile



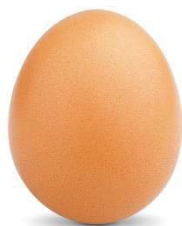
- **Rectangle** – Book, door, mobile phone



- **Triangle** – Pizza slice, road sign, sandwich



- **Oval** – Egg, balloon, mirror





Examples with Solutions

1. What shape is a clock?

Answer: A clock is usually a circle.

2. What shape is your notebook?

Answer: A notebook is a rectangle.

3. Which shape looks like a sandwich cut in half?

Answer: Triangle

4. What shape is a window that has four equal sides?

Answer: Square

5. What shape is an egg?

Answer: Oval
