# **Understanding the Topic**

- We see different shapes around us every day.
- Shapes help us identify and describe objects.
- Common shapes are circle, square, rectangle, triangle, and oval.
- Each shape looks different and is used in different things.

#### **Common Shapes and Where We See Them**

• Circle – Clock, coin, ball



• Square – Dice, window, tile



• Rectangle – Book, door, mobile phone



• **Triangle** – Pizza slice, road sign, sandwich



• Oval – Egg, balloon, mirror



# **Examples with Solutions**

1. What shape is a clock?

**Answer:** A clock is usually a circle.

2. What shape is your notebook?

**Answer:** A notebook is a rectangle.

3. Which shape looks like a sandwich cut in half?

**Answer:** Triangle

4. What shape is a window that has four equal sides?

**Answer:** Square

5. What shape is an egg?

**Answer:** Oval
