# **Subtraction**

### **Subtraction**

- Subtraction means taking away one number from another
- It helps us find what is left or how much more or less
- The answer we get after subtraction is called the difference
- We always subtract the smaller number from the bigger number
- Subtraction is done from right to left (ones to thousands)

## **Important Words That Show Subtraction**

- Left
- Take away
- Minus
- Difference
- How many more
- How many less

### **Steps to Solve Subtraction Problems**

**Step 1:** Write the numbers in columns using place value

**Step 2:** Always begin subtraction from the ones place

**Step 3:** If the top number is bigger, subtract directly

Step 4: Write the answer for each place value

**Step 5:** Read the final answer from left to right

#### **Examples with Solutions**

### Example 1

Problem: Subtract 123 from 645

**Solution:** 645 – 123 = 522

Answer: 522

# Example 2

Problem: Subtract 237 from 524

**Solution:** 524 - 237 = 287

Answer: 287

### Example 3

Problem: Subtract 412 from 800

**Solution:** 800 – 412 = 388

Answer: 388

### **Example 4**

Problem: Subtract 154 from 600

**Solution:** 600 - 154 = 446

Answer: 446

### Example 5

Problem: Subtract 208 from 700

**Solution:** 700 – 208 = 492

Answer: 492

### **Summary Points**

• Subtraction helps us find what is left or the difference between numbers

• We subtract the smaller number from the bigger number

• Look for keywords like "left," "how many more," or "difference" to identify subtraction problems
