



Position Words

What are Position Words?

Position words, also called prepositions, are words used before a noun or a pronoun to show the position or place of something or someone in relation to something else.

Examples of Position Words:

- **in** – The duck is in the pond.
- **on** – The cake is on the table.
- **under** – The cat is under the table.
- **near** – The tree is near the lake.
- **behind** – The car is behind the auto.
- **in front of** – The auto is in front of the car.
- **over** – The aeroplane flew over the house.
- **between** – The table is between two chairs.

Grammar Byte

Position Words / Prepositions tell us where something or someone is.

They are used before a noun or pronoun.

Example:

- The books are in the bag.
- The moon is between two clouds.

Points to Remember:

Position Words = Prepositions

They help describe the location or relationship between two things in a sentence.

Examples include: on, in, under, near, behind, over, between, in front of
