Parts of Plants



A plant has many parts. The main parts are: **the roots, the leaves, the branches, the flowers and the stem**. Each part has a set of jobs to do to keep the plant healthy. The roots absorb water and minerals from the soil and anchor the plant in the ground. The stem supports the plant above ground, and carries the water and minerals to the leaves.

Root:

- A. It absorbs water for the rest of the plant.
- B. Slowly stem transports materials between the leaves and roots.
- C. To trap sunlight makes the plant able to make food.
