Trees, Shrubs, Climber, Creepers and Water Plants

Let's learn some plants:

Trees:

- A. Big and tall plants are called trees.
- B. They are mostly of green colour.
- C. They have strong stem called trunk.
- D. Coconut, mango, neem, banyan etc are the examples of trees.

Shrubs:

- A. Small plants are called shrubs.
- B. Shrubs have many branches and they grow near to the ground.
- C. Their stem is thin and woody and doesn't have main trunk.
- D. Shrubs are smaller than trees.
- E. Example: Cotton plant, Rose plant, Mums plant.

Herbs:

- A. Herb plants are very small plants with a green color soft stem.
- B. Herbs leaves, flowers, seeds are used for flavoring, food, cooking, medicines or perfumes.
- C. Example of herbs is Coriander, Spinach, mint etc.
- D. These are seasonal plants.

Trees, Shrubs, Climber, Creepers and Water Plants

Climbers:

- A. Climber plants have a soft and weak stems.
- B. Climbers need support to stand and grow straight.
- C. Example: Money plant, Pea plant, Bean plant, Grape vine etc.

Creepers:

- A. Creeper plants have a soft green stem.
- B. Creepers grow along the ground.
- C. Example: Pumpkin, Watermelon, Muskmelon, cucumber etc.
- D. They cannot stand straight.

Water Plants:

- A. Water plants grow in water.
- B. The most of their stem stays underwater.
- C. Few water plants have big floating leaves.
- D. Some Plants like Hydrilla grow completely underwater.
- E. Lotus, Duckweed Hydrilla, water lily, jalkhumbi etc are example.
