

Ordering of Number



Ascending Order

Arranging numbers from the smallest to the greatest is called the **increasing/ascending order** of numbers.

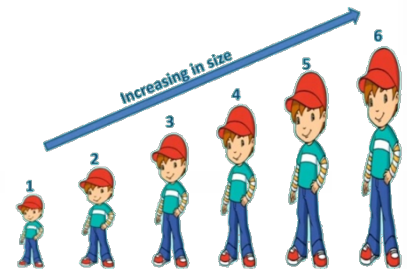
For example, heights of six persons are 155 cm, 150 cm, 140 cm, 160 cm, 145 cm and 165 cm respectively.

Compare the numbers and write them in the increasing/ascending order.

The numbers in ascending order, from the smallest to the greatest are

140 cm, 145 cm, 150 cm, 155 cm, 160 cm, 165 cm

Increasing/Ascending Order



Descending Order

Arranging numbers from the greatest to the smallest is called the **decreasing/descending order** of numbers.

The number in descending order, from the greatest to the smallest are

165 cm, 160 cm, 155 cm, 150 cm, 145 cm, 140 cm
