Subtraction of 2-digit Number without Regrouping

The sign (-) indicates subtraction. It is called the 'minus' sign.

When we subtract one number from the other, the answer is called their **difference**.

The subtraction 16 - 3 = 13 is read as sixteen minus three is equal to thirteen.

Let us subtract 12 from 75.

Write the number one below the other as shown.

**Step 1:** Subtract the ones.

5 ones - 2 ones = 3 ones.

Write '3' in the ones place.

Step 2: Subtract the tens.

7 tens - 1 ten = 6 tens.

Write 6 in the tens place.

The difference is 63.

Always write the greater number above the smaller number.
