

Word Problem Based on Subtraction



Let's know how to use subtraction in our day to day life.

Kavita had 82 books. She gave 16 books to her little sister. How many books are left with Kavita now?



Step 1: Read the problem and understand the question. How many books are still with Kavita after she has given some to her sister?

Step 2: Find the important information in the problem. Kavita had 82 books. She gave away 16 books.

Step 3: Decide what to do. We need to find out how many books are left with Kavita. So we must subtract.

Step 4: Solve the problem. Kavita is left with **66** books.

Step 5: Check your answer.

Does your answer make sense? Have you calculated it correctly? Kavita has less books after she gave some to her sister. The answer makes sense. $16 + 66 = 82$. So the calculation is correct.
