Collective Nouns

Definition

Collective Nouns are words that name a group of people, animals, or things considered as a single unit.

Example:

- A team of players
- A flock of sheep
- A bouquet of flowers

Examples of Common Collective Nouns

Collective Noun	Used For	Example Sentence		
Army	Soldiers	An army of soldiers marched past us.		
Team	Players	A team of players won the match.		
Herd	Cattle, Elephants	A herd of elephants crossed the river.		
Flock	Birds, Sheep	A flock of sheep grazed in the field.		
Bunch	Grapes, Keys, Bananas	She gave me a bunch of grapes.		
Bouquet	Flowers	He gifted her a bouquet of roses.		
Crowd	People	A crowd of people gathered to protest.		
Litter	Puppies	A litter of puppies was sleeping together.		
Shoal	Fish	We saw a shoal of fish in the lake.		

Collective Noun	Used For	Example Sentence		
Pack	Wolves, Cards	A pack of wolves howled in the forest.		
Gaggle	Geese	A gaggle of geese waddled across the yard.		
Band	Musicians	A band of musicians played on the street.		
Choir	Singers	A choir of singers performed in the concert.		
Library	Books	A library of books is available in the hall.		
Fleet	Ships	A fleet of ships sailed across the ocean.		

Grammar Byte

A collective noun refers to a group. It is singular in form but refers to many. It may take a singular or plural verb, depending on the context.
