
Grandpa asked the shopkeeper to show us a bright lunch-box.

He showed us a big red apple-shaped box. But I did not like it. I wanted a car-shaped lunch-box. Then the salesman showed




me a car-shaped lunch-box. But the shape of the

car did not interest me. I wanted a sports car as my lunch-box.


