

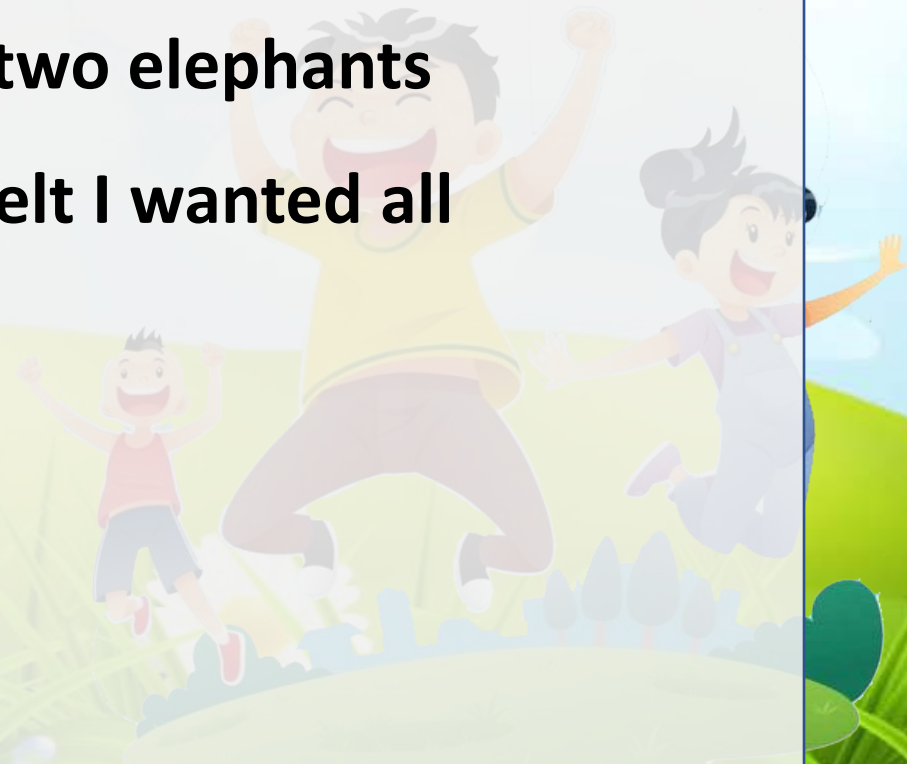

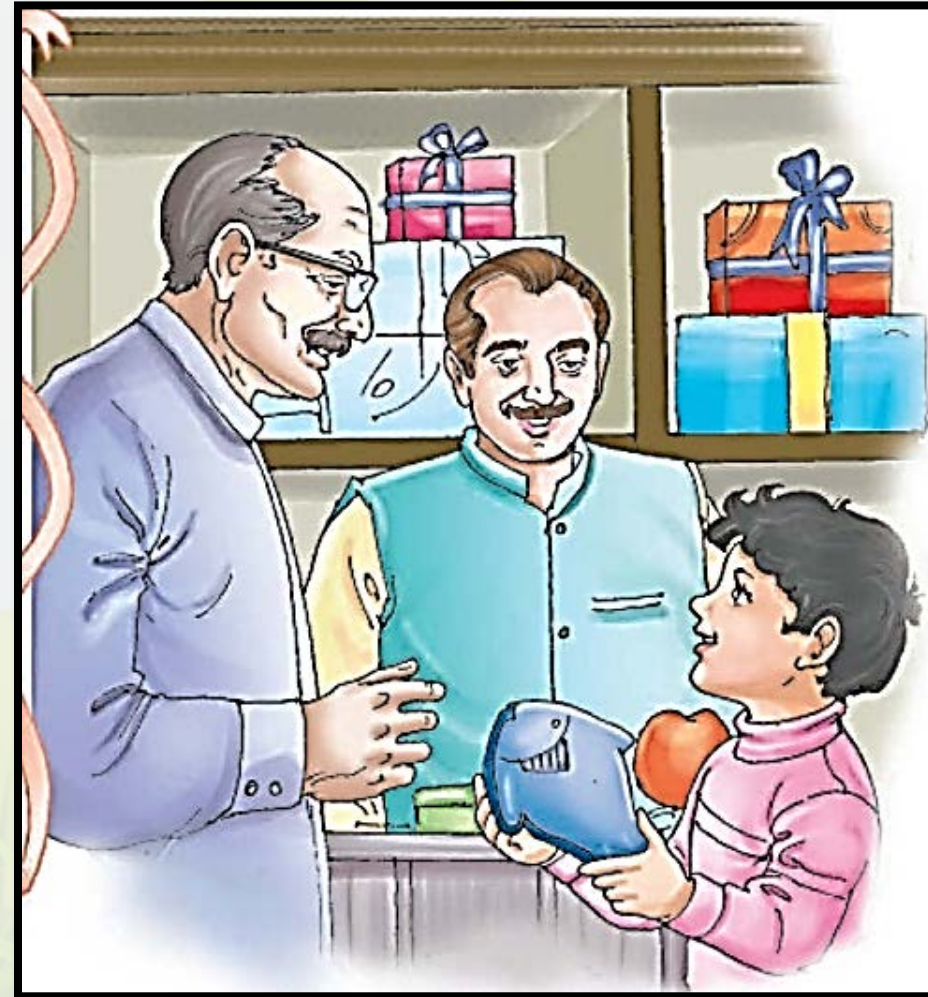


**Grandpa asked the shopkeeper to show us a bright lunch-box.

wanted a car-shaped lunch-box. Then the salesman showed**

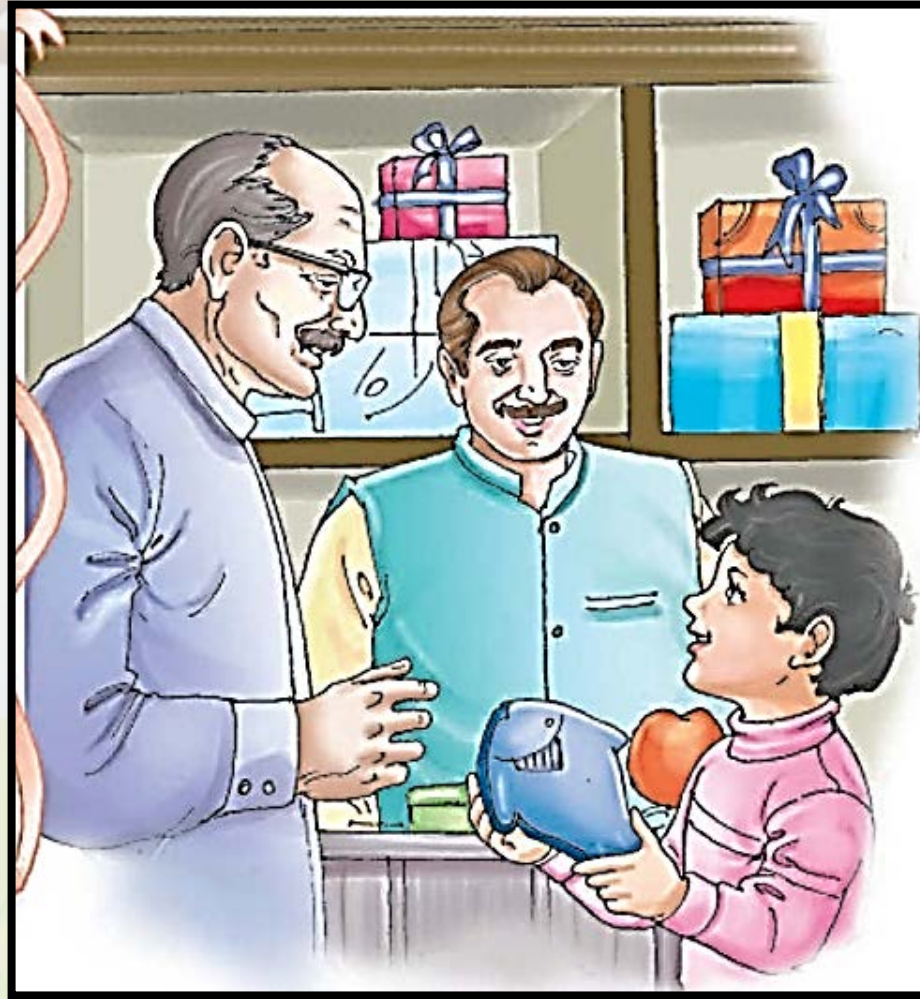




me a car-shaped lunch-box. But the shape of the car did not interest me. I wanted a sports car as my lunch-box.
