




Measuring Time

Sometimes, we measure time by looking the position of the Sun.



When the Sun rises, we call it early morning.



When the Sun is right above our head, we call it noon.






















Sometimes, we measure time by looking the position








Observe the face of the clock.

Numbers from 1 to 12 are shown on it.




The clock has two hands.
