

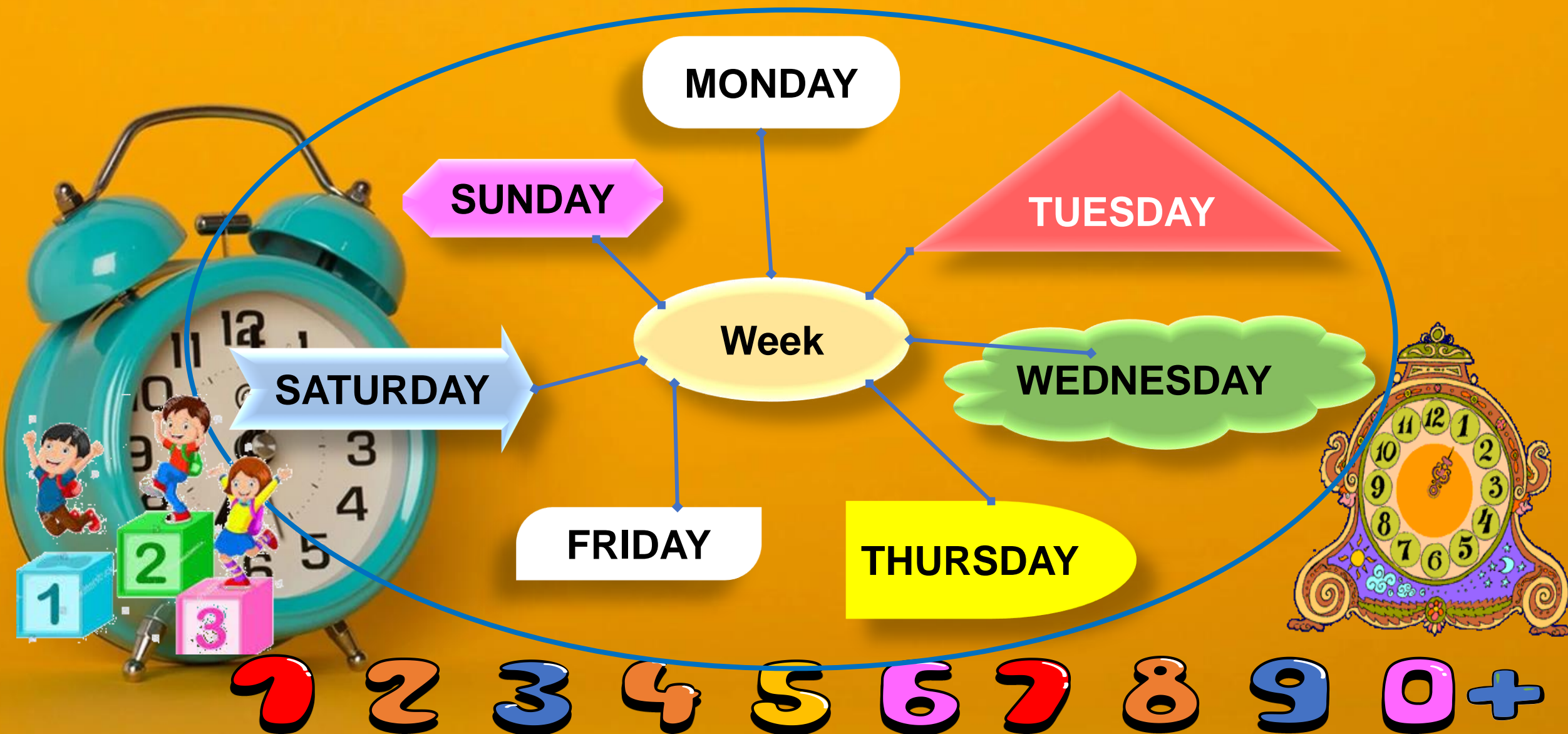

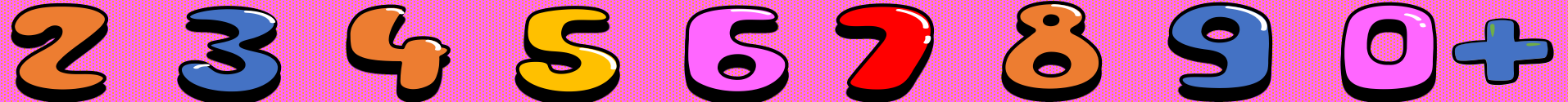

# Measuring Time

Sometimes, we measure time by looking the position of the Sun.



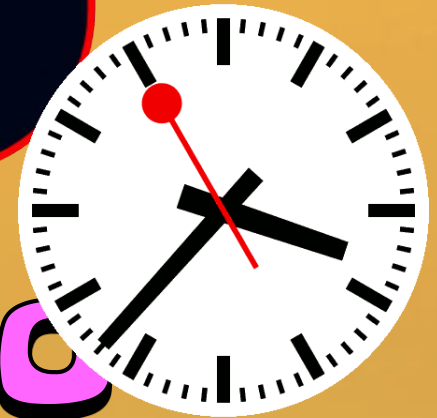
When the Sun rises, we call it **early morning**.



When the Sun is right above our head, we call it **noon**.

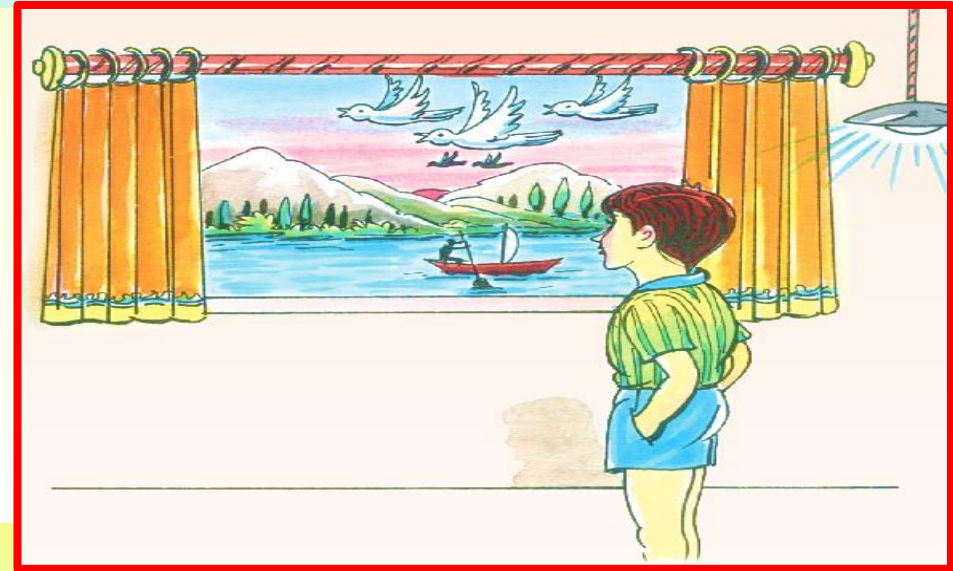




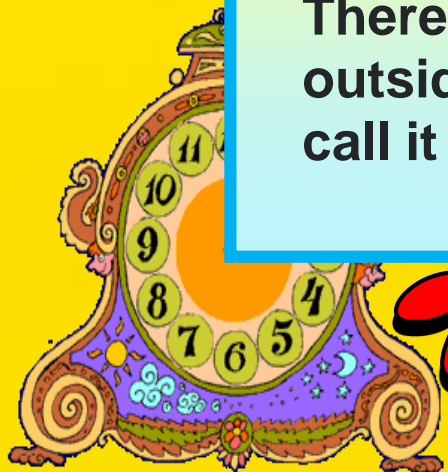
Sometimes, we measure time by looking the position of the Sun.



There is no Sunlight, it is dark outside. We see stars in the sky. We call it **night**.



We cannot see the Sun. We can see that the birds returning back to their nests. Sunlight fades away. We call it **evening**.

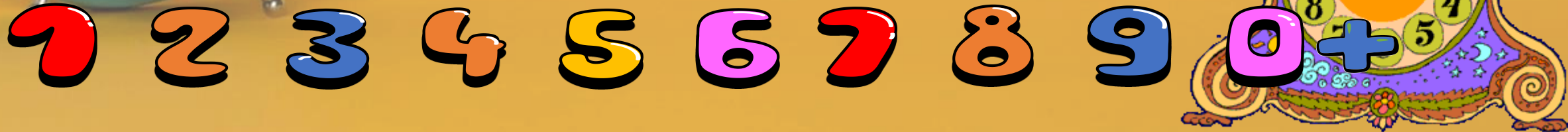

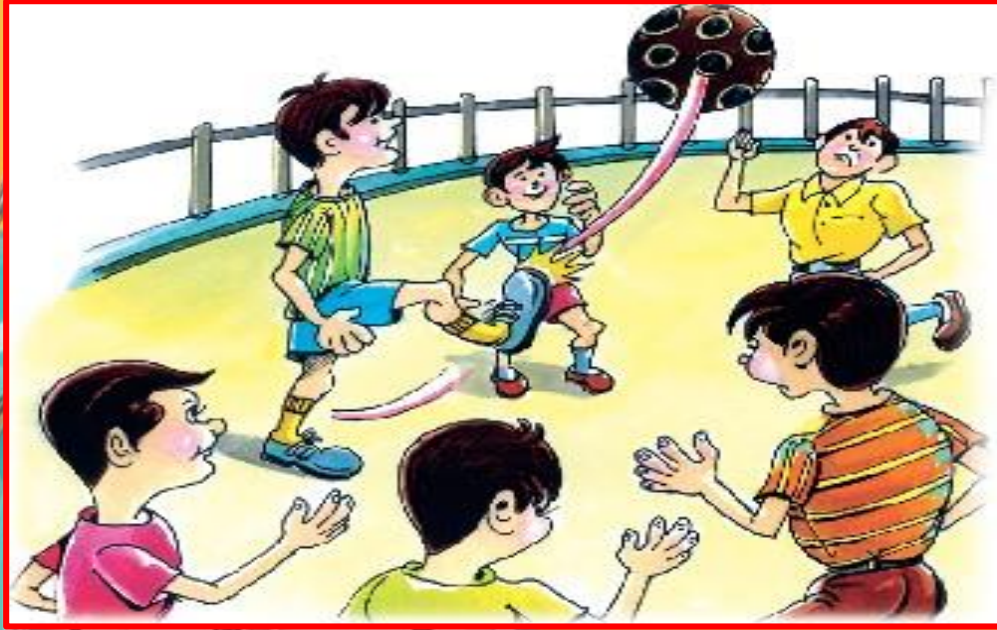

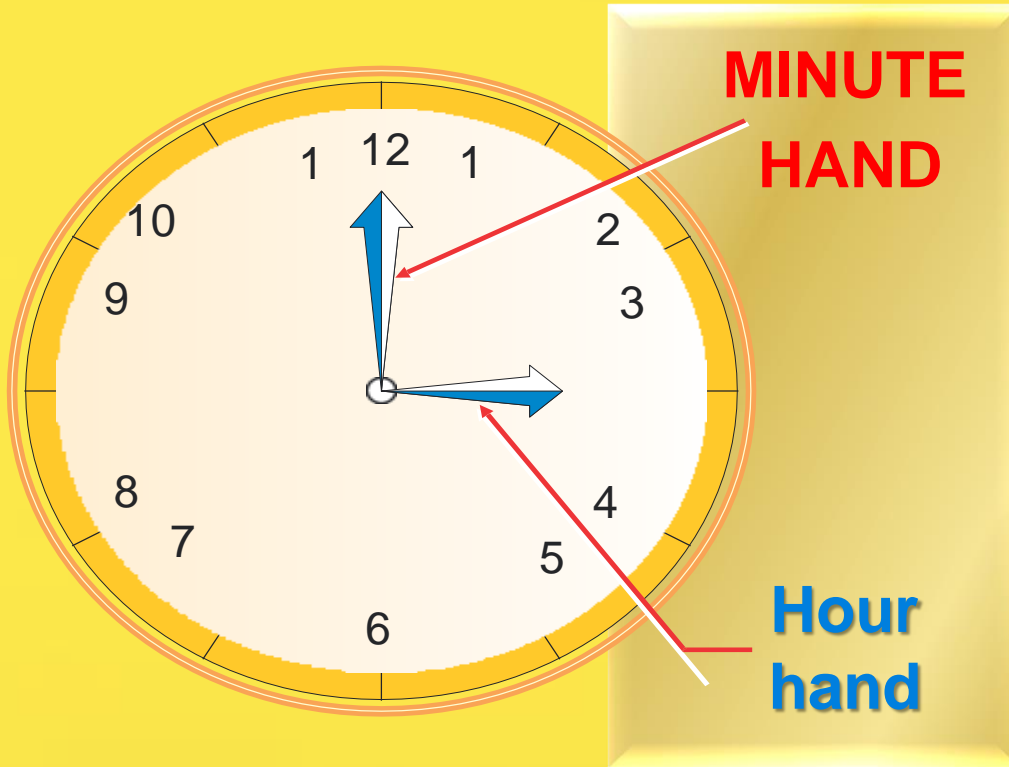

# Clock



Observe the face of the clock.

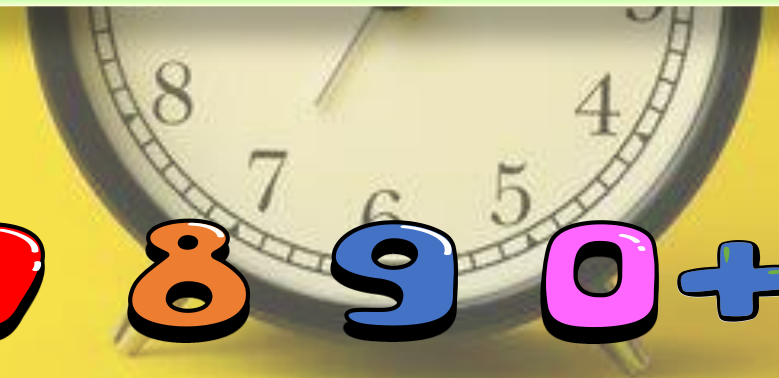
Numbers from 1 to 12 are shown on it.



The clock has two hands.

The longer hand is the '**minute hand**', which indicates time in **minutes**.

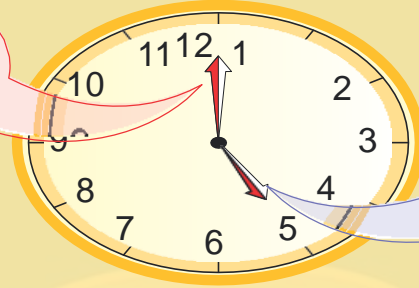
The shorter hand is the '**hour hand**', which indicates time in '**hours**'.





## Reading the Clock

The minute hand is at 12.



The hour hand is at 5.

The time is **5 o'clock.**



The minute hand is at 12. The hour hand is at 3. The time is **3 o'clock.**



The minute hand is at 12. The hour hand is at 9. The time is **9 o'clock.**
