External Part of the Body

Our body is basically classified into following types:

Head:

This is the uppermost part of the body. The head is the part of an organism which usually includes the ears, brain, forehead, cheeks, chin, eyes, nose, and mouth, each of which work in various sensory functions such as sight, hearing, smell, and taste.

Neck:

Neck connects the head to the rest of the body. The part of the body of an animal or human being that connects the head and the trunk.

Trunk is the central part of our body and all the important organs are situated in it. The human or animal body apart from the head and limbs. It has the main support of the body that is backbone.

Limbs:

They are of two types- hind limbs i.e. our hands and fore limbs i.e. our legs. "Limb" is another name for the arms or legs. Upper limbs are called hand and legs where as lower limbs are legs.
