- B. If light cannot get through an object the surface on the other side of that object will have less light reaching it.
- C. Shadow is a dark patch formed behind an opaque object when it is placed in the path of light.
- D. A shadow is formed only when a light source, an opaque object and a screen are present, e.g. during a lunar eclipse we see a part of the earth's shadow on the surface of the moon.
