

On the Basis of Bearing Flowers

Flowering plants:

Some of them bear flowers all over the year while some during a particular season. Flowering plants produce flowers which ensure the fertilization process. This allows for more rapid pollination e.g. jasmine, rose.



Non-Flowering plants:

Those plants which do not bear flowers are called non-flowering plants. However, some plants do not use flowers to reproduce. There are two main groups of non-flowering plants. Plants that use spores to reproduce and plants that use seeds to reproduce e.g. fern, cycas.
