On the Basis of Lifespan

On the basis of life span they are divided into three parts:

Annuals:


Some plants grow in a particular season examples are paddy, wheat.



Biennials:

Some plants can grow in more than one season, in first season only stem and leaves develop while in the next season fruits and flower develop e.g. onion, tulip.







Perennials:

Some plants live for many years but give fruits for a particular time period. E.g. coconut, neem.
