Perching Birds

Those birds which mainly reside on the branches of trees, wires are called as perching birds e.g. Sparrow, crowns, pigeons. Perching birds like the crow, sparrow and mynahs have long, slender claws. They have four toes three in the front and one at the back. This kind of toes help the birds to hold the branches of trees firmly and they can even sleep while perching. Perching birds hop on the ground.
