Subtraction of Weights

Example: Subtract 25 kg 756 from 30 kg.

Here, 30 kg > 25 g 756 g

Arrange the given weights in columns of kg and g as shown.

Steps of Subtraction:

Step 1: Write 3 zeroes in the 'g' column.

Step 2: Subtract grams. But 0 < 6, so we cannot subtract. Hence, we borrow 1 from the 'kg' column and subtract.

Write 244 in the 'g' column.

Step 3: Subtract kilograms 29 – 25 = 4kg.

Write 4 in the 'kg' column. Thus, the answer is 4 kg 244 g.
