Introduction of Subtraction

- We have already learnt about the subtraction of 2-digit and 3-digit numbers without and with borrowing, subtraction facts, checking subtraction with addition and subtraction stories in previous class. Before moving further let's recall it.
 - The answer in subtraction is called **difference**.
 - While doing subtraction, arrange the numbers in the columns of ones, tens and hundreds, first subtract the ones, tens and then the hundreds.
 - When you subtract zero from a number, the difference is the number itself. 25 0 = 25
 - When you subtract 1 from a number, the difference is the predecessor of the number. 48 1 = 47
 - When you subtract a number from itself the difference is **0.15 15 = 0**
