## **Word Problem of Subtraction**



## **Example:**

An orchard has mango trees and papaya trees. Out of the total 4842 trees, there are 1986 mango trees. How many papaya trees are there?

## **Solution:**

Total number of trees = 
$$\begin{bmatrix} 3 & 17 & 13 & 12 \\ 4 & 8 & 4 & 2 \\ 1 & 9 & 8 & 6 \end{bmatrix}$$

Number of papaya trees =  $\begin{bmatrix} 2 & 8 & 5 & 6 \end{bmatrix}$ 

Hence, the number of papaya trees is 2856.
