Multiplication by 100, 200... 900

To multiply any number by 100, just add two 0 to its right.

55 × 100 = 5500 32 × 100 = 3200

To get the product of a number by 200, multiply the number by 2 and place two zeros to its right.

For example: To find the product 3×200 , first multiply 3 and 2 that is 6. Now, place two zeros to its right, that is, 600. Therefore, $3 \times 200 = 600$

Apply the same rule with other numbers such as 300, 400, 500, 600, 700, 800 and 900.
