

Conversion of Money

⇒ We know that Rs 1 = 100 Paise

Converting rupees into paise

We have learnt to write money in rupees and paise.

For example: The cost of a car toy is 5 rupees 50 paise = Rs 5.50

As Rs 1 = 100p

So Rs 5 = (100×5) P = 500 P

And Rs 5.50 = 500 P + 50 P = 550 P

⇒ **Let us take few more examples.**

Example 1: Convert into paise.

A. Rs 7

B. Rs 25.25

C. Rs 52.75

Solution: A: Rs. 7

$$= 7 \times 100 \text{ [As Rs. 1 = 100P]} = 700 \text{ P}$$

B: Rs 25.25

$$\text{Rs. 25} = (25 \times 100) \text{ P} = 2500 \text{ P}$$

$$\text{So Rs 25.25} = (2500 + 25) \text{ P} = 2525 \text{ P}$$

C: Rs. 52.75

$$\text{Rs. 52} = (52 \times 100) \text{ P} = 5200 \text{ P}$$

$$\text{So Rs. 52.75} = (5200 + 75) \text{ P} = 5275 \text{ P}$$
