Understanding the Topic

- We use **money** in the form of **rupees (₹)** and **paise**.
- 100 paise = **1 rupee**
- So, we can change **paise into rupees** and **rupees into paise**.
- This is called **conversion**.

Things to Remember

- 1 rupee = 100 paise
- 2 rupees = 200 paise
- To **change rupees into paise**, we **multiply by 100**
- To **change paise into rupees**, we **divide by 100**

Examples with Solutions

1. **How many paise are there in ₹1?**

Answer: 100 paise = ₹1

2. **Convert ₹5 into paise**

Answer: ₹5 = $5 \times 100 = 500$ paise

3. **Convert 200 paise into rupees**

Answer: $200 \div 100 = ₹2$

4. **Convert ₹3 into paise**

Answer: ₹3 = $3 \times 100 = 300$ paise

5. **Convert 50 paise into rupees**

Answer: $50 \div 100 = ₹0.50$

Summary Points

- 100 paise = **₹1**
- To change rupees to paise, **multiply by 100**
- To change paise to rupees, **divide by 100**
- Conversion helps us **use money correctly**
- We can convert money to understand its value better
