
## **Explanation:**

2. Identify a Square:

**Solution:** Four equal straight lines.

3. Identify a Triangle:

**Example:** (a piece of pizza)

**Solution:** Three straight lines joined together.

4. Identify a Rectangle:

**Example:** \( \sqrt{a} \) (a ruler)

**Solution:** Opposite sides are equal, four straight lines.

5. Identify an Oval:

Example: (an egg)

**Solution:** It is like a circle but longer.
