













Multiplication Table of 4

Understanding the Topic

- Multiplication means adding the **same number again and again**
- The **table of 4** helps us add **4** many times
- It is like counting by 4s: 4, 8, 12, 16, 20...
- Example:
 - 4×1 means 4 one time = 4
 - 4×2 means $4 + 4 = 8$
 - 4×3 means $4 + 4 + 4 = 12$

Multiplication Table of 4

Objects	How to read?	How to write?
 4	1 time 4 is 4 or 4 one is 4	$4 \times 1 = 4$
 $4 + 4$	2 times 4 is 8 or 4 two's are 8	$4 \times 2 = 8$
 $4 + 4 + 4$	3 times 4 is 12 or 4 three's are 12	$4 \times 3 = 12$
 $4 + 4 + 4 + 4$	4 times 4 is 16 or 4 four's are 16	$4 \times 4 = 16$
 $4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4$	5 times 4 is 20 or 4 five's are 20	$4 \times 5 = 20$
 $4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4$	6 times 4 is 24 or 4 six's are 24	$4 \times 6 = 24$
 $4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4$	7 times 4 is 28 or 4 seven's are 28	$4 \times 7 = 28$
 $4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4$	8 times 4 is 32 or 4 eight's are 32	$4 \times 8 = 32$
 $4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4$	9 times 4 is 36 or 4 nine's are 36	$4 \times 9 = 36$
 $4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4$	10 times 4 is 40 or 4 ten's are 40	$4 \times 10 = 40$



Examples with Solutions

1. What is 4×2 ?

👉 $4 + 4 = 8$

Answer: 8

2. What is 4×3 ?

👉 $4 + 4 + 4 = 12$

Answer: 12

3. What is 4×5 ?

👉 $4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 = 20$

Answer: 20

4. What is 4×6 ?

👉 4 added six times: $4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 = 24$

Answer: 24

5. What is 4×10 ?

👉 Count by fours ten times: 4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24, 28, 32, 36, 40

Answer: 40

Summary Points
